Member of public raised serious safety concerns that already exist. The traffic impact documents do not install faith in the safety. Very little information in the document. And the document is very woolly with phrases such as 'where possible' 'where reasonably practicable' etc.

Member of public raised concern of parking in Greenbank Road on bend opposite HR. The secretary and PKC have already addressed this and someone will be coming out to look at it. Around 40% of school walk that way in the morning and it is blind at that corner. Secretary to provide update at next meeting.

If TTRO put in place restricting parking on Church Brae where will these people park? Into dangerous places already highlighted. Concerns that this will change the village.

Microgrants – 3 applications

Greener Glenfarg to do trips of interest to meet other groups. Approved

Glenfarg and Duncrevie in bloom. Replacement of signs. Asked for support. Approved

Village Inn – Expense for architect to produce report – approved

Application form to be amended to include a statement requiring an 'end of grant' report to allow the Community Council to sign off the award.

Allotments – approached by member of the public as to why allotments are not moving forward. We investigated this last year and this was parked when no obvious locations could be identified. We are keen to support the member and will go back and advise we shall support him in taking it forward.

Wind Farm at Carnbo – Ppsl for 25 and 10 turbines. We fall within catchment area similar to Binn Turbines etc. Milnathort and Glenfarg CC are going to unite to approach them. Meeting to be arranged to take forward with representatives.

Meeting frequencies – As there is so much more going on should this be monthly? Thoughts for this for next meeting

Flood – Proposed meeting with Ruari Stewart (Flood Team), Garry McConnel (Roads) and CCIIr Christie to look at the culvert leading from The Avenue. This appears blocked and would benefit a camera team attending to ensure clear and effective.

Website – Bill Macpherson looking to make it mobile friendly. Info in certain cases is out of date and may no longer be relevant. Greener Glenfarg Group, Transport Group and CC need to update before end of Sept.
