## ***Community Council***

The following is an extract from the minutes of the Community Council meeting held on 5 July 1993, at which no members of the public were present.

**TREASURER'S REPORT** The Council's financial position is continuing at a satisfactory level. Costs of maintaining the marquee are covered by hire charges, and £140 has been sent to Arngask School for the prize fund. £420 remains outstanding from Newsletter advertisers.

**KINROSS CRIME PREVENTION PANEL** is considering the installation of video cameras in the town centre, the extension of the Neighbourhood Watch Scheme and the development of youth club activities. Tayside Police advise that, when answering the 'phone, subscribers should say "Hello" rather than disclose their telephone number. Mrs. Ponton added that she is always available to help, and deal with queries from, residents on matters concerning crime and its prevention.

**ROADS** A reply has been received from the Director of Roads and Transport, TRC, to matters raised by the Council:

**Lomond Bank** The Director is not prepared to recommend the adoption of a small length of this road, even if it were brought up to TRC standards. If adoption is desired the whole length of the road must be brought up to standard, the cost being met by the frontagers.

**Snow clearing** The possibility of enlisting help from local farmers will be considered.

**Road through Glenfarg** Some culvert replacements are being undertaken. Other work is in various stages of preparation.

**Footbridge across M90** Site has been inspected and a suitable solution is being investigated.

**Speed restriction, Duncrievie** It is hoped that signs will be in place during the next two months.

**Greenbank Road** not referred to in the Director's letter, but it has been noted that the road surface has been marked for repair at the appropriate points.

**PERTH ASSOCIATION FOR MENTAL HEALTH** An appeal has been received for volunteers to assist in the befriending of sufferers. Training is available, and the expenses of volunteers reimbursed. Any person willing to offer assistance should contact the Chairman (of the Community Council).

**ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS** for the future show Glenfarg in District Ward 13 (Dupplin) of Electoral Division 38.

**LANDFILL SITE AT BINN FARM** Notification has been received from the Director of Planning of the acceptance of the applicant's proposals.

**TRC COMMUNITY AWARD SCHEME** Application forms with details are available from the Post Office.
