POSSIBLE PRIVATISATION OF THE POST OFFICE The Chairman proposed that the Community Council should lend its support to TRC in its condemnation of the suggestion of privatisation, highlighting the important social role which the Post Office plays in the life of the village. The Secretary undertook to send an appropriate letter to TRC.

TURNING AREA ALONGSIDE ARNGASK SCHOOL the unadopted road alongside Arngask School was now in such a poor state of repair that damage had been caused to a number of cars. TRC roads department had agreed in May 1990 to include this road in the programme of work for 1994/5. The Secretary undertook to write to the roads department requesting that repairs be carried out as soon as possible.

DUNCRIEVIE SPEED LIMIT residents of the area had noted that the speed limit was not being obeyed. The Secretary undertook to contact the Police to request an increased police presence to enforce the limit.
